THE INSTITUTION

CARE Group of institutions runs six Undergraduate B.E Programs, three Postgraduate M.E programs and an M.B.A program in the academic year 2016-2017.

STAFF DETAILS

CARE Group of Institutions currently has 90 Teaching faculty, 20 Technical Staff and 107 supporting staff that includes 11 Transport staff, 20 Kitchen staff, 6 Estate staff, 25 House keeping staff, 24 Security staff and 8 Gardeners.

INFRASTRUCTURE

CARE has an unparalleled academic infrastructure on both aesthetic and functional aspects. Every year additional facilities are created and in the current academic year a good progress has been made towards this.

- Three new playgrounds have been created with one playground dedicated for a 400 m athletics track and other two for sports activities.
- Five Guest rooms have been created in Hostel.
- A Gym facility has been created in boy's hostel housing all basic equipments.
- Two ECE labs have been relocated above Physics lab for better functionality.
- A pantry has been created in Administrative block.
- Intercom facilities provided within the college building.
- 4 security cameras installed at vantage points as per the norms of control bodies.
- Executive rooms of Administrative Block has been provided with air conditioners.
- Recreation hall has been fully air conditioned.
- P.A.Systems installed in Seminar hall, conference hall and Board room of MBA.
- An approach road of 100 ft wide has been laid from NH, upto entry plaza with 8 additional lamp posts on both sides of the approach road.
- Lawn sprinkler system extended on both sides of road from entry plaza to Administrative Block.
- Fencing work completed from NH to Hostel adjacent to Panchayat road.
- 500 saplings have been planted along Panchayat road fence, along lily pond road and in Hostel areas.

INTERNET CONNECTIVITY

BSNL internet leased line of 10 Mbps, and Blue lotus Internet leased line of 10 Mbps have been established for internet connectivity. Wi-Fi facility augmented in the 2nd floor seminar Hall area and in CSE class room area of College buildings.

Microsoft dream spark license has been obtained this year for training purpose. The software supports learning in the areas of MySQL, Visual studio, Share point etc.

LIBRARY

In the current academic year 450 volumes have been added in the library resulting to a total volume of over 18,500 books covering all disciplines of Engineering, Sciences, and Management. Our reference section holds 926 reference volumes, 1279 CDs & DVDs, 45 Journals, 734 Project reports and 989 Journal back volumes. About 1000 e-journals have been activated in e-library through DELNET and Inter library loan facility enabled through DELNET.Net library users has already crossed 7715 by Feb 2017.

In the current academic year we have become a member of National Digital Library. This enables us to gain access to National resources such as National reports, e-books, ejournals, Audio/video lectures, NPTEL link etc.

Library is extensively used by our staff and students. As per statistics of library users, in the current academic year on an average each member has visited the library 12 times.

TRANSPORT FACILITY

A total of 9 buses are plying now in various routes for students and staff members to commute from different places to college.

ADMISSION

The campus has a total admitted strength of 138 students with 93 admissions in first year UG, 22 admissions in first year PG and 23 admissions in lateral entry in the current academic year.

UNIVERSITY RESULTS

Our College has performed reasonably well in this year University results.

100 % results have been achieved in 21 subjects,

90-99 % results have been achieved in 41 subjects and

80-90% range results have been achieved in 42 subjects.

DEGREES AWARDED

We are proud to state that CARE students have bagged 2 University ranks including 1 Gold medal in Anna University convocation held in Nov 2016. Mr. N. Bharath Kumar of ME Construction Engineering Management has secured Anna University First Rank & Gold medal and Mr. R. Vadivelu of same class has secured 19th Rank in the AU Examinations. Our hearty Congratulations to the students, staff and department concerned.

CARE Group of institutions has completed eight academic years. The fourth batch of B.E and sixth batch of M.B.A have been graduated. Degrees for above students were released in the recent Anna University convocation.

EVENTS ATTENDED BY STUDENTS AND STAFF

Attending external programs help students and staff to acquire wide external exposure in their areas of interest and to benchmark themselves by sharing knowledge with experts and their peers.

In the academic year 2016-17,

- Students participated in 5 different National Technical Symposia in other colleges and 10 Technical training/events like Workshops, Seminars & Short term Courses in various events.
- Our faculty attended 9 National Conferences/Symposiums, 4 Seminars, 6 Workshops and 27 Faculty Development Programs. Our faculty also delivered 3 guest lectures in other institutions.
- Around 25 Management oriented programmes like CDP, FDP, Start-up Trichy series have been conducted in the current academic year and around 42 Distinguished guests visited our campus for various programmes.

TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT CELL

Training and Development cell (TDC) of CARE is effectively engaged in developing students and faculty in all needed skills by providing vivid programs every year. The training needs are identified based on various feedbacks and requests from faculty, students, and stakeholders. Based on the above, training schedules are designed and organized every year.

In the current academic year Final year students were given Placement training during winter vacation from 24/11/16 to 30/11/16 on Communication, Aptitude, C, Java, soft skills, Group Discussion, Mock interviews etc. For II and III year students 4 hours per week have been allotted for training on soft skills and on technical skills for placements and Competitive exams. A one week FDP was conducted during 19-24th Dec 2016 for faculty members on topics like Goal setting, Leadership, Team spirit, Mentorship etc.

CLUB ACTIVITIES

Club activities are imperative for cultural awareness, high ethical and moral values and to seed a sense of social responsibility. For those with an intense fervour and zeal for the stage, Clubs provide an opportunity to showcase their skills and voice their emotions and innermost thoughts.

Dramatics & Music club

Dramatics club, one of the most prestigious clubs of the college has the responsibility to bring smiles on everybody's face across the campus. Cultural Clubs organized and conducted 9 programs out of which 3 programs were conducted to motivate and encourage the students of CARE to shed inhibitions and portray their talents. Music club comprises of 15 members and it has exhibited three performances in Student Associations of ECE, CIVIL and MECHANICAL.

Literary club

The inevitability of English can't be denied in the modern world as it is the most widely spoken global language. To meet this challenge, English Literary Club performs a notable number of activities throughout the year. The club has identified and pruned enthusiastic students for the much coveted "RYLA AWARDS" and "TOP NOTCHER AWARDS" sponsored by the Rotary Club of Tiruchirappalli. A competition on "JAM (Just a minute talk)" was conducted on 17/10/16. A Debate on "Demonetization "was conducted on 12/01/17.

Tamil literary club

Tamil Literary Club of CARE gives myriad opportunities for the students to express their sense of appreciation towards the aesthetic Tamil language that has established its roots deep in the history of languages. Tamil Literary Competitions were conducted at CARE on 12/08/16 and 26/09/16. Elocution, Poetry Writing, essay Writing and Drawing Competitions were conducted. Students have participated in intercollegiate Tamil Literary competitions conducted at Nadar Saraswathi Engineering college, Trichy, Mahalingam Engineering college, Pollachi and Shrimathi Indira Gandhi college, Trichy and won many accolades.

National Youth Day, World Habitat day and NSS day were celebrated with due involvement from NSS volunteers. A Clean Campus campaign was conducted on 5th November 2016 to clean up all plastic garbage. To emphasize electoral participation National voter's day pledge was taken on 25th January 2017. Visaka Awareness Campaign was conducted on 11th February 2017 in Navalur, Kuttapattu to spread awareness on Cashless transaction and Digital India.

In the Academic year 2016-17 Youth Red Cross started and functions in close coordination with NSS.

SPORTS
