I, Dr.N.Meikandan, Director, CARE Group of Institutions deem it a pleasure to present you the 11th Annual Day report of CARE Group of Institutions for the academic year 2019-2020.

THE INSTITUTION

CARE Group of institutions at present has Four Undergraduate B.E Programs, Three Postgraduate M.E programs including Mobile and Pervasive Computing and in addition MBA, offered through CARE Business School, all approved by AICTE.

We have proposed to start 1 additional UG course 'B.Tech - Artificial Intelligence & Data Sciences' to AICTE. Also proposed to start 1 PG course 'M.E - Computer Science (Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning) in lieu of 'Mobile and Pervasive Computing' and waiting for AICTE approval.

STAFF DETAILS

CARE School of Engineering currently has 66 Teaching faculties, 15 Technical Staff and 90 supporting staff that includes 15 Office staff, 7 Transport staff, 15 Kitchen staff, 19 Housekeeping staff, 18 Security staff, 4 Maintenance staff and 6 Gardeners.

INFRASTRUCTURE

CARE has an unparalleled infrastructure on both aesthetic and functional aspects. Every year additional facilities are created/modified for the ever changing educational requirements.

In the current academic year following have been developed:

- Pathways inter connecting the blocks in Boys Hostel and in Girls Hostel completed.
- Ambiance of 'CARE Square' has been enhanced by enabling a structure within.
- On Holistic approach a Temple constructed near Administrative Block..
- Installation of name boards to labs for identification purposes initiated.
- Re-laid metal road from the Entry plaza to Hostels.
- A new Foot Ball Ground commissioned closer to hostel.
- Proposed to utilize the build-up space better by relocating necessary instructional areas from Phase.2 to accommodate CARE College of Arts and Science.
- Proposed relocating instructional area from Phase.1 to Phase.3 except central lab & workshop area to accommodate School of Architecture in Phase.1.

INTERNET CONNECTIVITY

In the current academic year available Broad Band internet services has been enhanced from 40 Mbps to 52 Mbps. Leased line, from Limras Eronet Broad band services Pvt Ltd (Blue lotus) of 30 Mbps and a BSNL Broad Band services of 22 Mbps have been subscribed at present.

LIBRARY

In the current academic year so far 186 volumes have been added in the library resulting to a total volume of 19,386 books with 6,734 titles covering all disciplines of Engineering and Sciences. We have currently subscribed to 36 hard copy Journals, 5000+ online e-Journals and 12 hard copy Magazines. Our reference section holds 1,358 CDs / DVDs 1,136 Project reports, 245 Question Banks and 1,366 Journal back volumes as on

today. In the current academic year we started collecting e-books and have added so far 5,761 e-books to the library.

Being a member Institution of National Digital Library (NDL) and Tamil Nadu Digital Library (TNDL) we already have access to National resources such as e-reports, e-books, e-journals, Audio/ video lectures, Rare books, Research thesis, manuscript, etc.

Number of General library users this year has crossed 8,992 and e-net library users have crossed 702 as on Feb 2020.

In the current year through NPTEL local chapter, 111 online enrolments have been made so far. Librarian holds additional duty of acting as NPTEL co-ordinator of CARE.

In our continuous effort to upgrade library human resource, our librarian was sponsored to attend a regional workshop on 'Strategies for Transforming Libraries: Growing Trends & Technologies' organized by DELNET, New Delhi on 20th November 2019.

TRANSPORT FACILITY

A total of 5 buses are plying now in various routes for students and staff members to commute from different places to college.

ADMISSION

In the current academic year, CARE Group of Institutions has a total strength of 336 students with 43 admissions in first year UG, 34 admissions in first year PG, 8 admissions through Lateral entry and 1 admission through Transfer scheme.

UNIVERSITY RESULTS

This year our performances in University exams are reasonably well even though the introduction of 'outcome based education' and related exam question papers systems are new to our students. The stringed procedures established in R2017 in allowing students to move to higher semesters have made the students in general to be more serious about the exams.

Average all pass % of CARE-UG considering last 2 semesters is 30 %.

Considering theory subjects in last 2 semesters:

100 % results have been achieved in 3 theory subjects.

90-99 % results have been achieved in 9 subjects and
80-89% results have been achieved in 28 subjects.

DEGREES AWARDED

CARE Group of Institutions has completed Ten academic years and we are progressing in the 11th year. Seven batches of B.E and Five batches of M.E have passed out.

In '2019 passing batch', 48.2 % of CARE Group of Institutions students have been awarded degrees in the convocation held at Anna University, Chennai in December 2019.

CLASS TOPPERS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-2019

Considering Even 2018-19 and Odd 2019-20 semesters, **17** of our students have secured higher AGPA and emerged as class toppers in their respective departments.

1 student has earned above 9 AGPA and 6 students have earned above 8 AGPA.

RESEARCH GRANTS / TEST & CONSULTANCY PROJECTS

1. In the current academic year, Department of Mechanical Engineering, generated a fund of Rs.61,200/- through SEM & XRD testing and analysis services.
2. Mr.J.Muthukumar and Mr.Sunil Allen were awarded Grants of Rs.40000/- by DST, under NIMAT project scheme to conduct an Entrepreneurship Awareness Camp, during September 2019. Mr.J.Muthukumar is one of the nominees for the prestigious Dr.V.G.Patel Memorial Award for the best Trainer/Educator/Mentor award.

3. Dr.J.Jeyarani of ECE applied for CSIR sponsorship for conducting FDP on the topic 'Future Trends in Non Invasive Methods of Sensing Photonic Crystal Fiber'

PLACEMENTS

In the current academic year 85% of the final year students opted for Jobs while most of the remaining students opted either to become entrepreneur or prefer to go for higher studies. Thanks to the earnest effort put by CARE Placement Cell lead by Mr.P.Selvakumar. 100% of the 'job opted Engineering students' of '2020 passing batch' have been placed with placement offers from 19 companies in the pay band of Rs. 1.2 LPA to 4.56 LPA. 14 students got 2 offers, 2 students got 3 offers and 3 students got 4 offers.

RESEARCH PUBLICATIONS

CARE always encourage faculty to do research in their field of specialization. In the current academic year Mr.P.Selvakumar of ECE was approved by Anna University for registering Ph.D under part Time scheme.

CARE also encourage staff to do research in collaboration with students, as it serves a strong motivation factor for students along with good research exposure and confidence.

In the Academic year 2019-2020,

6 research works have been published in International Journals.

3 research works have been presented in International Conferences.

EVENTS ORGANIZED

In addition to academic activities, CARE believes in ‘personality development’ of students by way of organizing various events like National level Symposia, Guest lectures, Workshops, Seminars, Short term courses, Professional & career development courses etc.

INDUSTRIAL VISITS AND IN-PLANT TRAINING

Industrial visits and In-plant trainings provide opportunities to students to get exposure and experience from actual industrial working environment thereby enabling them to interpret and understand the class room concepts better. In the current academic year,

- Our students made department wise industrial visits to 7 Industries.
- Students underwent in-plant training & internships in 25 Industries

In the academic year 2019-20,
