17. This is a non-exclusive MoU.



- 2.4 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Data Science using Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning and Data Analytics.
- 2.5 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to guide and train the Faculty of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.6 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in-house requirements.
- 2.7 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

CLAUSE 3

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or Otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the Other Party.

CLAUSE 4

VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period TenthPlanet Technologies Pvt Ltd, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective Steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of TenthPlanet Technologies Pvt Ltd, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as extension of this MOU.

- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.


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NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGRREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each Other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.

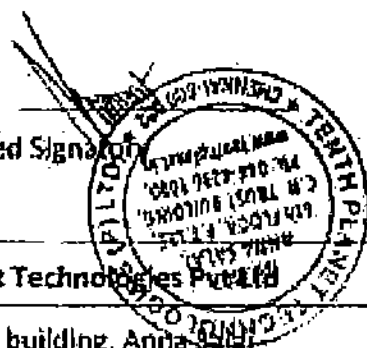
