
The First Day began with the Inauguration of "Grand Finale of Smart India Hackathon 2022" enlightening the Significance of the event and Speech by Dignitaries. Later, we were informed regarding the Rules and Regulations to be followed and the Schedule of the event. There were two Sessions per day namely Mentoring Session at Morning and Evaluation Session at the Evening.

The Mentoring sessions held for about 7-10 min that dealt with the corrections and tips by the judges for the betterment of the project. While the Evaluation session (10 min approx.) forms the Main Phase as the Daily progress of the project has been delivered based on which the Marks were assigned.

The Criteria for Evaluation was based on the **Day-by-Day progress** followed by the efficient use of the components provided and the Innovation in the Project. There were also some Cultural events conducted at evenings reflecting their own lifestyle of living.

The **End of the event** marked the Finalization of Results, Valedictory session and the Prize distribution Ceremony. In addition to the Project, we came across people practicing different culture, food habits, environment, etc...., which forms the favourite part in the entire journey of Hackathon.







SWING TRADING



What is Swing Trading?

Swing Trading is a style of trading in which traders seek to profit from the **Price swings** of financial assets, such as stocks, currencies, or commodities. Unlike day trading, where traders buy and sell assets within a single day, swing traders hold their positions for several days or weeks, taking advantage of **short-term price fluctuations.**

Attributes of Swing Trading

Swing traders use Technical Analysis to identify trading opportunities. They look for Chart Patterns, such as support and Resistance levels, Trend lines, and moving Averages to determine **Entry** and **Exit** points for their trades.

They also use Indicators, such as
Relative Strength Index (RSI) or Moving
Average Convergence Divergence
(MACD), to confirm their trading signals.

Characteristics of Swing Traders

Swing trading requires a certain level of skill and experience, as traders need to have a good understanding of technical analysis, risk management, and market psychology. It also requires Discipline and Patience, as traders need to wait for the right trading opportunities and stick to their **Trading plan**.

Overall, swing trading can be a **profitable** strategy for traders who are willing to put in the time and effort to learn the necessary skills and develop a sound trading plan. However, like any trading strategy, it carries risks, and traders should always be mindful of their risk tolerance and the potential losses they could incur.




MY JOURNEY OF PHOTOGRAPHY
