Remuneration Guidelines for Practical/Project Examinations

UG and PG Practical Examinations

Remuneration for internal and external examiners is 10 (Rupees Ten) per candidate examined with a minimum of 75 (Rupees Seventy-Five) per practical subject.

Remuneration for skilled assistant is 6 (Rupees Six) per candidate present with a minimum of 50 (Rupees Fifty) per practical subject.

UG Project Viva-Voce Examinations

Remuneration for internal and external examiners is 40 (Rupees Forty) per project batch examined with a minimum of 100 (Rupees Hundred) per project subject.

PG Project Viva-Voce Examinations

Remuneration for internal and external examiners is 50 (Rupees Fifty) per candidate examined with a minimum of 100 (Rupees Hundred) per project subject.

Remuneration for supervisor is 50 (Rupees Fifty) per candidate examined.

External examiner shall claim 100 (Rupees Hundred) per thesis for evaluating M.E. theses and 50 (Rupees Fifty) per thesis for evaluating M.B.A./M.C.A. theses.

Allowance for Incidental Expenses

Allowance for Incidental Expenses (AIE) for external examiner is 350 (Rupees Three Hundred and Fifty) per day. If the examination is conducted in a session (half a day), the AIE for the external examiner is 300 (Rupees Three Hundred). External examiner shall claim AIE only once per day or session irrespective of number of practical/project subjects examined.

If all the registered candidates are absent, external examiner, internal examiner and skilled assistants are permitted to claim the minimum remuneration and external examiner is permitted to claim AIE.

Examiners and skilled assistant are not permitted to claim the minimum claim if the subject code of regular and arrear practical's/projects is one and the same.
