Question Paper Pattern with Part-A and Part-B

All the questions shall be of supply type.

Part-A $(10\times2=20 \text{ Marks})$

- Each question shall carry 2 marks.
- There shall be ten questions, and students need to answer all the ten questions.
- ➤ Students shall take around 2 minutes to answer one question.
- ➤ Questions can be in Remember or Understand or lower levels of Apply Knowledge Levels.
- ➤ There shall be two questions from each unit. Out of the two questions, one question shall be from the first half and the second question shall be from the second half of the unit.

Part-B (5×16=80 Marks)

- Each question shall carry 16 marks.
- Each question can have a maximum of two subdivisions.
- ➤ The marks for the subdivisions shall be mentioned clearly at the end of each question with inbracket as shown in the following sample.

- ➤ Students shall take around 23 minutes to answer one question.
- ➤ There shall be five either or questions.
- ➤ Questions can be in Understand or Apply or higher Knowledge Levels.
- ➤ There shall be two questions (one either or) from each unit. Out of the two questions, one question shall be from the first half and the second question shall be from the second half of the unit.
- ➤ The two questions from a unit shall address the same Course Outcome and be in the same Knowledge Level.

Note: There should be only one question from a topic of the syllabus in a question paper.

Same question should not be available in both the question papers.
