Question Bank Pattern with Part-A and Part-B

All the questions shall be of supply type.

Part-A

Each question shall carry 2 marks.

Students shall take around 2 minutes to answer one question.

Questions can be in Remember or Understand or lower levels of Apply Knowledge Levels.

There shall be four questions from each unit. Out of the four questions, first two questions shall be from the first half and the second two questions shall be from the second half of the unit.

Part-B

Each question shall carry 16 marks.

Each question can have a maximum of two subdivisions. The marks for the subdivisions shall be mentioned clearly at the end of each question with in bracket as shown in the following sample.

1.	i) Discuss in detail the uses of ethical theories.	(8)	Un CO2
	ii) Explain the theory of duty ethics and its classification.	(8)	Un CO2

Students shall take around 30 minutes to answer one question.

Questions can be in Understand or Apply or higher Knowledge Levels.

There shall be four questions from each unit. Out of the four questions, first two questions shall be from the first half and the second two questions shall be from the second half of the unit.

It is preferred that the four questions shall address same Course Outcome and be in the same Knowledge Level.

If it is very difficult to set questions with the above condition, there may be a maximum of two Course Outcomes and two Knowledge Levels per unit.

Note: All the questions in the question bank shall be mutually exclusive.
